Steve Wormser's Photo Walk around Redlands is a mini-workshop designed for busy people like you. Scheduled for the first Saturday of every month, each Photo Walk lasts only 1 1/2 to 2 hours. Odd numbered months feature morning start times. Late afternoon or early evening sessions occur during even numbered months.

Visit a different area of Redlands each month. As you walk through the area, Steve will demonstrate the best ways to photograph the surroundings, focusing on lighting and composition. All levels of photographers and all types of cameras are welcome.

~~PHOTO CHALLENGE GROUP — Eager to grow as a photographer by expanding your critical, technical, and creative skills?

This group will challenge you as a photographer and improve your photographs. The *Photo Challenge Group* is a series of 12 interactive workshops that meet once each month over the course of a calendar year. Participants set assignments, submit photographs, and discuss one another's finished work.

Each month the group selects an emphasis for the photography that will be submitted for critique the following month, such as a specific color palette, a scenic photograph, an architectural study, a still life, a design element, etc. Participants then have one month to shoot photographs that conform to the selected emphasis and select three to submit for class critique at the following month's session. (You are allowed to go back six months in your archives for photos you have taken.)

At the next meeting, the group will discuss one another's photographs, focusing on lighting, composition, and exposure. A majority vote by the group will determine the best photo of the three submitted by each participant, and a final group vote will determine which participant did the best job overall on the project for that month.

~~BASIC COMPUTER 1 - Getting started with your camera and computer. Learn how to download photos to your computer, how to store photos in the computer, how to back up your photos, and how to set up your photos on I-Pads. A majority of people think they know what they're doing on the computer and backing up their photos. Once they take this class, 95% of participants will recognize the mistakes they've been making without a proper back up procedure. It's predicted that the average person will lose 30% of their digital photos within 5 years because they have not backed them up properly. That's a loss of family history that is completely avoidable by learning the proper techniques for storing your photos on your computer.

You will be shown how to do simple adjustments on your camera to make dramatic changes in your photographs. You will also work on lighting and composition.

The *Photo Boot Camp* has Eight 2-hour classes. If you sign up for a session and you miss a class, you can attend the class you missed when we have it during the next session.

~~RENT A PRO - A one-on-one custom designed class. A custom 4-hour one-on-one session is designed around whatever photography, lighting, or computer help you need. The 4 hours is broken into two 2-hour sessions. This often works best for people with busy schedules that don't fit into our class calendars. Rent A Pro can also be adapted to provide instruction in a specific area not covered by our other classes.

CREATIVE PHOTOGRAPHY:

In the Creative Photography series of classes, we are working on your creativity. To take these classes you should understand your camera and be somewhat comfortable with it. These classes are 30% technical and 70% creative. We want you making images that will knock someone's socks off and make them say "WOW!"

Pre-requisite to the Creative Photography Classes is Photo Boot Camp. For experienced photographers who have not taken our Photo Boot Camp, we do have a photographic test we give to confirm you have the photographic knowledge to take the Creative Photography Classes.

~~CREATIVE PHOTOGRAPHY: ADVANCED PHOTOGRAPHY – Pre-requisite: Completion of Photo Boot Camp.

With the Advanced Photography Class you will now build upon the technical knowledge gained in our Photo Boot Camp and learn how to create images that convey emotion. These classes will show you how to take your images up to the next level by exploring and experimenting with different techniques, using different lighting, and controlling your final image. We want to challenge you to continue to develop your skills and style, thereby helping you raise your standards to achieve a higher quality of image.

The classes meet every other week so you have time to work on each project. During the Final Class, everyone shows the work they created during the previous 8 classes.

~~CREATIVE PHOTOGRAPHY: ADVANCED PHOTOGRAPHY II -

Pre-requisite: Completion of Advance Photography

With the *Advanced Photography Class II* you will building upon the technical knowledge gained in our Advance Photography Class and learn how to create images that convey emotion and energy. You will continue up to the next level by exploring and experimenting with different techniques, using different lighting, and controlling your final image. We want to challenge you to continue developing your skills and style, thereby helping you raise your standards to achieve a higher quality of image. Each class will have 60-90 minutes of lecture and then 90 minutes of shooting photographs on the same day.

<u>Creating Abstract Photographs</u> Abstract photographs can be made many ways. Many times they might be a portion of an overall image. They can be created by motion, lighting, and depth of field. An abstract photo may never show the exact subject captured by the photographer. *Feb 15 3-6 p.m.*

<u>High Key Photography</u> This class will teach how to create High Key in studio and outside. You will use flash in the studio and the sun outside. You will learn of the more challenging ways to light a subject. *Mar 28 4-7 p.m.*

<u>Low Key Photography</u> A Low Key photograph is reproduced primarily as black or dark hued colors or tones. This style can be organically discovered, or created through lighting, props, and post-production techniques. Low Key photographs are generally soft single light images. Using this technique can really set a mood to the image, and can be created with many different light sources. *May 12 6:30-9:30 p.m.*

<u>Color Contrast</u> Color contrast can change the mood of an image. It can come out so strong that the effect practically run you over, or it can be very subtle so that you barely notice the tonal changes. *July 14 6:30-9:30 p.m.*

Leading Lines You will learn how Lines lead you through the photograph. This can be done many ways for different effects. *Aug 22 5:00-8:00 p.m.*

<u>Dynamic Angles</u> Dynamic angles are more than just a high or low angle of a photograph. These are angles that can be created by the camera angle, but also with the use of a different lens. **Sept. 19 4:00-7:00 p.m.**

<u>Negative Space</u> Negative space is the empty, or unoccupied, space surrounding the subject in a photo that helps to define it. It is one of the least understood art concepts with photographers. Simple empty space does not signify the proper use of negative space. *Oct. 17 4:00-7:00 p.m.*

<u>Rules of Odds</u> The Rule of Odds goes back long before photographers discovered it. It is an art concept dating back to the earliest painters. The Rule of Odds states that artwork is more visually appealing when there are an odd number of objects in the finished composition. *Nov. 21 2:00-5:00 p.m.*

~~CREATIVE PHOTOGRAPHY: PICTURE SERIES -

Pre-requisite: Completion of Advanced Photography

With the *Picture Series Class* you will now build upon the technical knowledge gained in our Advanced Photography Class and learn how to create images that convey emotion and a story. It is often said, "A single picture is worth a 1,000 words." In this era of slide shows and online photo books just think how the right combination of many pictures could be used to skillfully create a visual story without words. This class will teach you how to shoot, edit and lay out a picture series or story. Each class session will have a specific assignment to shoot, followed by instruction on editing, placement of photos, and final layout. You should have some form of photo editing software on your computer.

The classes meet every month, so you have time to work on each project. During the Final Class, everyone will show the work they created during the previous 10 classes.

We will talk about the different ways to light your subject for each assignment. You do not need any special lighting equipment for this class. The following week the class will discuss your images.

~~NOAH PURIFOY DESERT MUSEUM -

Noah S. Purifoy was an African-American visual artist and sculptor, co-founder of the Watts Towers Art Center and creator of the Noah Purifoy Outdoor Desert Art Museum. The museum features sculptures made from vacuum cleaners, bicycles, toilets, bowling balls, and many other items.
